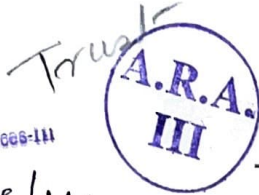

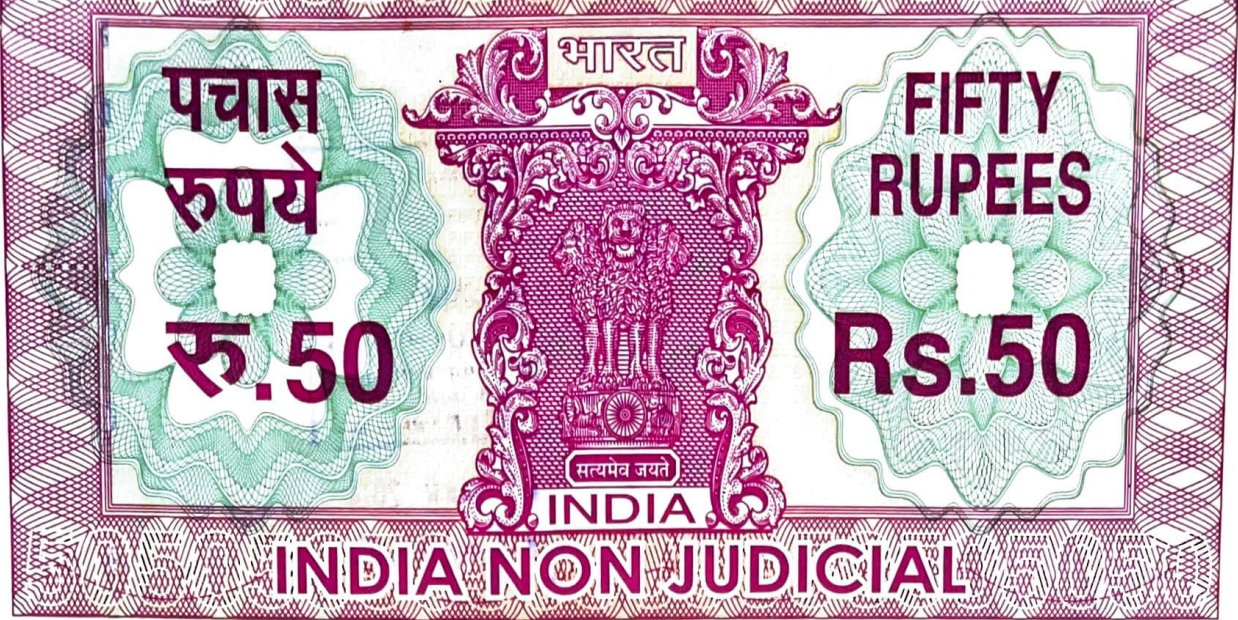

**AND WHEREAS** with a view to and for the purpose of constituting the Trust permanently for the purpose of carrying on the objectives of the Trust as mentioned hereafter under the "Aims and Objects" clause of this Deed of Trust, it is

The Registered Head office of the Trust be located at Vill- Vidya Danga Bonhat, P.O.- Kharbona, P.S.- Rampurhat, District- Birbhum, Pin-731224, West Bengal, India, the office of the Trust may be opened to any other place in West Bengal or to any other of India or open local office or offices at Places deemed necessary.

4. **INTERPRETATION:-**

a) Trust means the Trust created by this

**CHARITABLE TRUST:-**

- b) The Board shall mean the Board of the members which may be filled up by co-option of the existing Trustees created by this Deed with renowned and suitable persons.
- c) **TRUST PROPERTY:-** shall include every kind of property movable and immovable to be owned by the Trust and mentioned in accounts, books and other documents in the

possession, custody and control or that ought to be in possession, custody and control or possession of the Trust.

**5. AIMS AND OBJECTS OF TRUST:-**

- i. To promote, establish, start, maintain, organize, run, manage, supervise, superintendent, co-ordinance, affiliate, control, guide and grant aid to the Church, schools, college, B.ED. College, D. Ed. College, Universities, Engineering & Polytechnic College, hostels, laboratories, libraries, home for the aged, auditorium, practical classes, and other educational institutions for the promotion of the arts, literatures, :
- ii. To promote , maintain all round development of Kabarthan in various places.
- iii. To promote and Establish teaching Institute for the Christian and Minority Children .
- iv. To establish, maintain, control, manage and or render financial assistance medical college, including all treatment facilities to hospitals, health centers, nursing home, dispensaries, maternity homes, clinics, sanatorium and other establishments for providing medical facilities and to promote medical research in these centers in all faculties and systems of medical practices and provide medical help including supply of medicines providing Ambulance services, arrangement of medical van and medical unit to the public irrespective of any caste, colour and need and to promote research for medicines for cancer and other incurable diseases:
- v. To start, support, organize and give financial aid to the social, cultural and moral renaissance of the people and to develop physical, mental and educational capacity of the society and to promote schemes for such purposes:
- vi. To organize and undertake social welfare programmes and activities to foster social unity and to reform the society through moral and ethical movements for awakening of the self in relation to the society and to organize the dedicated youth to serve the suffering of humanity:
- vii. To establish, maintain and grant aid to institutions for the relief of the poor, minority and advancement of education for the aforesaid purpose or purposes and to grant periodical and other occasional help to the deserving persons:



- viii. To do, any other act for the advancement or general public utility without distinction or discrimination of sex, colour, caste, creed or religion:
- ix. To grant relief on the occasion of famine, earthquake, other epidemic and other occasion of calamities of similar nature and to give donations, subscriptions, or contributions to the institutions, establishments or persons during relief work on such occasions:
- x. To undertake traditional and experimental activities for the welfare of the children, women, handicapped, blind persons and destitute in the social structure:
- xi. To establish, maintain, control, manage and give financial aid to orphanages, widow-homes launch, asylum home for destitute and insane persons and other establishments for relief:
- xii. - xvii. To co-operate with the Government and Non-Government organization for any development activity of the rural and urban areas:
- xviii. To raise resource and funds from any sources as consistent with the principals and objects and in conformity with the interest of the said **TRUST**:



- xix. To co-operate and connect with national, international organizations, having similar objectives and reputes or receive representatives from such organizations:
- xx. To purchase, take or loan or exchange or hire movable and/or immovable property for fulfillment of the purpose of the **TRUST**:
- xxi. To take loan from any Government Department, Non-Government Organization and nationalized bank to propagate the **TRUST'S** aims and objects for economic upliftment of the community:
- xxii. To work for development of social welfare, health and education for the children of rural and urban area:
- xxiii. To work for development of community awareness and vocational education for the rural women:
- xxiv. To organize seminars, workshop on forum for consumer protection, environmental programme, plantation/national integration etc.
- xxv. To perform work on progress of knowledge for rural people and to establish and maintain libraries, reading rooms, adult literacy classes, for educational technical, agricultural or medical knowledge:
- xxvi. To cultivate the art and Islamic culture and habit of living and working together to enhance fellow feelings activities and integrated activity:
- xxvii. To promote social, civic, moral activities to take care for orphans or of aged helpless man/woman:
- xxviii. To arrange functions, spiritual sittings, exhibitions etc. for the progress of arts, literature, science, culture etc. in the rural and urban areas:
- xxix. To develop and improve medical activities and facilities to rural people and minorities with providing medical support to sick, helpless handicapped people, to establish charitable dispensary, health Centre old age home etc:
- xxx. To seek receive and take any subscription or gifts or donation of all kinds like money or property both movable or immovable donated by any organization or individual either in INDIA or abroad for any of the objects of the **TRUST**:
- xxxi. To help or to co-operate to individuals or associates or clubs or any other organizations, to establish and to maintain any/or all the objects of the TRUST and to help and to issue affiliation to any similar organization either in establishing or in their work progress only after getting Indemnification Bond from them and cancel their affiliation in case they engage themselves in any wrongful/illegal activity and their cancellation shall be published in Newspaper:
- xxxii. To create job opportunities for the local/zonal and other people by establishing S.S.I. Unit/Handicraft Unit/ Medical



- Sub-unit/Home Industries for the development and upgrading economy of the unemployed youth of both sexes, handicapped, orphans and other categories of people, knitting, tailoring etc. and to organize training programmes for such developmental programmes, issuing Certificates after training courses for the benefit of the trainees, concession, for training periods, in Govt. bus and train, only for the poor and minority students:
- xxxiii. To promote Agri-Horticulture Industries & Research Institutes for transfer of technology.
  - xxxiv. To promote all kind of research projects on modern science and technology, to establish rural center for snake-biting treatment and for research work upon these subject:
  - xxxv. To perform jobs relating to prevention of atrocities or cruelty on animals:
  - xxxvi. To work for the promotion of Yoga and Naturopathy:
  - xxxvii. To establish rural museum for upkeep and preservation of age-old sculptures, work of art etc:
  - xxxviii. To establish rural libraries for providing text books to the minority students and rural students living below the poverty line:
  - xxxix. To organize creche, vocational homes, residential schools, family planning programme I.C.D.S. and other Government programmes, extending schemes as the TRUST BOARD may deem fit and proper.
  - xl. To undertake housing and resettlement activities for economically or otherwise disadvantaged people in rural and urban areas by way of concept formulation surveying planning supervising, producing of low cost and innovative building materials, construction, financing, management, research and development and/or training:
  - xli. To raise fund by way of loan, donations, fees etc. from any person/s, the state or central Government Organizations, companies corporate agencies, institutions or otherwise for the TRUST and/or to provide funds to such beneficiaries as many be identified by the TRUST:
  - xlii. To arrange for a conservation of such parks where rare species of animals and birds breeding and bird rescue Centre, shall remain and growing and take care of them shall be done for gathering knowledge by student of school and colleges:
  - xlili. To arrange so that this organization may take loan from banks/F.I./D.F.I./N.R.I.L. etc for the following projects form time to time as under:
  - xliv. To organize and establish Girja and/or Research Centers, such other Institutions for the promotion or moral values in the day to day life.



- xlv. To publish and print magazines, journals, news papers and books.
- xlvi. Renewable Energy Projects like Solar, Sind, Bio-mass/ Bio-gas/Horticulture/Floriculture/Vermi-culture/ Pisciculture/Animal Husbandry/Medicines Plants/ Sericulture Plants/Sericulture Projects etc. in the rural areas:
- xlvii. To take up any Water-shed management projects in the adjoining areas:
- xlviii. To propagate the idea of integrated social development in all possible manner:
- xliv. To establish the training center on youth Development, Demonstration Projects, Tourism resorts in various parts of India.
  - i. It may go for micro-lending operation without any money interest to operate more beneficially to the rural poor/destitute, to promote Muslim fund.
  - ii. To use the profits of surplus income for the developmental activities but shall not be distributed among the TRUSTEES.
  - iii. To work for all round development of Minority O.B.C., SC/ST community.
  - liii. The TRUST can go for a marketing of above mentioned purposes:
  - liv. To promote literacy and to lay emphasis on primary, secondary and technical education, specially for the weaker and underprivileged section of the society and to set-up institution and establishments for the upliftment of the minority communities.
  - lv. To promote female education and create awareness among the girl and women and 'o establish schools, residential school, colleges, hostel coaching, technical institutions and vocational training centers for girls and women and also for boys.
  - lvi. To create awareness about sanitation, hygiene and health and to establish hospitals, nursing homes, health centers, nursing training centers and to organize health care centers, medical check-up camps and such other allied activities.
  - lvii. To promote and undertake integrated village development project, employment generation programmes, adult and continuing education programmes, crafts and vocational training centers, cottager and agro-industries training centers, agriculture motivation and training schemes, earning and saving schemes, deposit and credit schemes especially in rural areas and in slums.
  - lviii. To worker in conjunction of various project with governmental and semi-governmental authorities and/or non-governmental organization in India or abroad for the upliftment of the people in general and underprivileged

section of the society in particulars, especially in rural areas and in slums.

- lxi. To takeover, acquire, establish, start, run, maintain, or manage Schools, Colleges, Universities, Polytechnics, Reading rooms, study and Coaching center, Hostels, Boarding-House, Orphanages, Nursing's, and Midwifery Training center, Crafts Training production Centers for the Promotion of Education and vocational skill and underprivileged section of the society. To organize Herbal Research and manufacturing Center.
- lxii. To awards scholarship for deserving students for technical, medical, professional, religious, general and higher studies and also to provide financial; and/or loans to deserving students and scholars.
- lxiii. To establish and maintain adult Education Center especially in the Rural Areas and in Slums for eradicating illiteracy and ignorance and to appoint teachers and supervisors for managements of such Centers.
- lxiv. To Conduct organize Seminars, Symposia, Get-together, Public meting to create and develops general awareness and Communal Harmony, peace and to eradicate and abolish communal hatred and ill-feeling among the people.
- lxv. To receive loans from Bank, financial institutions and Government Departments to run credit schemes, self employment projects for the development of the backward and underprivileged section of the society, specially in rural areas and in slums.

- lxvii. To organize, manage and run diploma and certificate courses on Salesmanship, Entrepreneurship, Management, Marketing, leadership and such other programmes for



- students and youths and award certificates to the successful candidate for such courses.
- lxviii. To create awareness and implement the spirit as enunciated in the Prime Minister 15-point Programme for the development of the minorities.
- lix. To encourage athletic activities of youth and student and to conduct tournaments, sports and game for them.
- lxx. To associate, co-operate and collaborate with the assist and help any other society/trust having object and aims similar or akin to the object and aims of the trust in appropriate ways.
- lxxi. To organize relief work in the event of natural calamities, communal riots and social upheavals and/or such other purpose.
- lxxii. To affiliate with other organization in India and abroad having objects and aims similar or akin to the objects of the Trust.
- lxxiii. To protect Human Rights/Fundamental Rights of Indian Constitution & World Sanad (Viswa Sanad) 30 (Thirty) Articles, U.N.O.
- lxxiv. To Provide Food, Clothes, House, Education, water & Employment.
- lxxv. To protect Human Rights of the disabled, and issues of religious tolerance.
- lxxvi. To Form a Medical Institution & Alopactic Hospital for the poor people & General People & To Form a Medical College & Hospital.
- lxxvii. To Form a UNANI INSTITUTION & UNANI HOSPITAL for the General and poor people.
- lxxviii. To Form a Homeopathic Institution Homeopathic Hospital for the General People.
- lxxix. The Society will provide to form an English medium school up to Higher Secondary for the General people & the Minorities, to educate them and uplift their educational activities & knowledge.
- lxxx. The Society will provide the Research facilities, for the patients of Aids, Thalassemia, Cancer, HIV, Leprosy which will be under the heads of different specialists from within the country and abroad.
- lxxxii. To form an Old Age Home, Widow Home, Orphanage Home and also to form a "HOME" for the poor females who have no shelter, they shall be imparted training to enable them to earn their livelihood.
- lxxxiii. To form a Maternity Home with checkup of the body for the General people, & Health Centre with Nursing Training Centre for General People and the Minorities.
- lxxxiii. To form a Children Nutrition and Children Diseases Camp.
- lxxxiv. To form an Eye Donation Camp, & Eye Checkup and operation Camp free for the General people & the Minorities.
- lxxxv. To form a Blood Donation Camp.
- lxxxvi. To form English Medium School to educate the General Children & Minorities boys & Girls and uplift their knowledge.

- lxxxvii. To form Mental Hospital for the general people.
- lxxxviii. To form a Street Children Home for the General children & the Minorities Children.
- lxxxix. To form a Labour Welfare Trust with Multipurpose Activities.
- xc. To form Welfare activities for the Media & distressed public.
- xc. To form all kind of Welfare activities for the poor & Disposed Tailors.
- xcii. To form a Creche (Child Home) for the poor people & General People & the Minorities.
- xciii. To form a Social Welfare & Religious Mission for the General people & the Minorities.
- xciv. To form a Newspaper and Magazine for the General Public.
- xcv. To form a Marriage Fund for the poor female.
- xcvi. To form a R.G. Party for the security of Villagers.
- xcvii. To form a TECHNICAL INSTITUTION & HIGHER EDUCATION FOR the General people & Minorities People.

  - ciii. To form a Magazine & News Papers Printed, Edited and Published by the Trust.
  - civ. To form a Medical Hospital & Institution with all facilities of O.T. Wards, X-Rays, Pathology, Blood Bank, Medicines, Eye, Skin, ENT, children disease, Orthopedic dept, Heart disease etc.
  - cv. To Form a PEACE COMMITTEE during RIOTS for the General People.
  - cvi. To form "LIBRARIES" for the General People.
  - cvii. To arrange and organize lectures, debates, discussions, Seminars & excursions for the Enhancement of knowledge.
  - cviii. To publish or cause to be published useful literatures Magazines, etc.
  - cix. To study, cultivate and demonstrate the art of Christian CULTURE & Christian RULES & REGULATION.
  - cx. To promote and encourage advancement of literary, cultural, political, religious, Medical, Scientific and technical Education.
  - cx. To collect and preserve manuscripts, paintings sculptures, works of art, antiquities, natural history specimens, mechanical and scientific instruments and designs.
  - cxii. To help the aged, sick, helpless and indignant persons.
  - cxiii. To engage and assist in such other Philanthropic activities as may be deemed appropriate by the Governing Body of the Society.
  - cxiv. To construct, maintain, improve, develop buildings, house or other works necessary or convenient for the use of Societies.



- cxv. To do all such acts, deeds, matters and things as may be deemed incidental or conducive to the foregoing objectives.
- cxvi. To form a TOURS & TRAVEL CORPORATION for Educational, Cultural & HUMAN RIGHTS VISIT & INVESTIGATION TEAM to any places of India.
- cxvii. To organized Christian Mass Marriage for the benefit of poor people.

6. To perform that notwithstanding herein contained in the income as the corpus OF THE TRUST fund the same shall be applicable and applied to for PUBLIC CHARITABLE PURPOSE ONLY within such territories and subject to such conditions or limitation if any as may from time to time be laid down by the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any other acts governing taxation of income the wealth of PUBLIC CHARITABLE TRUST so as to render the TRUST hereby established as well as its income eligible for exemption from taxation under such Act or acts, now or prevailing or any modification replacement thereof.

7. To act in such a way that the TRUST hereby established shall always retain the status of one such TRUST to which provisions of section 80G/ 12A/ 35AC/FCRA 10(23C)IV/V/VIA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any modification replacement or thereof for the time being in force shall apply so that any donation or contribution thereto is recognized as eligible for exemption or relief from tax in the hands of the donor.

8. **ADMINISTRATION:-** The properties and funds shall vest in the name of Trustees constituted by persons executing the Deed of the Trust. The number of members of Board of Trustees shall not exceed 15(fifteen) and the vacancies can be filled by co-option by the existing Trustees.

The above office-bearers shall be elected by the co-option of the Trustee at a meeting convened for the purpose.

10. **VACANCIES:-**

A vacancy shall arise among the Trustees in the following cases-

- i. When a Trustee dies.
- ii. When he resigns his office as a Trustee.
- iii. If he becomes Bankrupt.
- iv. If he becomes in sane or otherwise become incapable to act or.
- v. When he is absent from three consecutive meeting of the Board, unless the Board records condoning such absence in the minutes of the meetings of the Board of Trustees for substantial cause.
- vi. When it becomes insolvent.
- vii. When convicted of any criminal offence involving moral Turpitude.
- viii. When he acts or does anything detrimental to the interest of the Trust.
- ix. On medical evidence when he is declared physically or mentally unfit by a resolution of the Board at a meeting convened for the purpose.

10. **FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE BEARERS:**

**PRESIDENT:-**

- i. President **WILL BE ELECTED BY THE MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS** trustees present in the meeting convened for the purpose.
- ii. The president is empowered to take decisions on urgent matters, but such be approved by the Board within a period of 30 days.
- iii. The President will preside over the meeting of the Trust and conduct the proceedings.
- iv. The president in his own decision or by the request of the third of existing members can call for the meeting of the Trustees.
- v. The President is empowered to delegate such powers to any other members of the Trust as he may deem fit.
- vi. The President is empowered to dissolve the committee or the Board in any abnormal situation.

**SECRETARY:**



The General who will act as managing trustee of the Board of Trust, elected under the control and supervision of the Board, shall conduct and manage all the affairs of the Trust, its all properties and institutions, sign papers and carry on the despondence on behalf of the Trust, and shall be responsible for the safe custody of records of the Trust, and keeping of the proper accounts thereof. He shall also perform such other duties as may be entrusted to him from time to time by the Board provided that in the absence of the General Secretary. The President, the Vice-President of the Assistant General Secretary or any other Secretary especially authorized on the behalf may sign papers and carry on correspondence on behalf of the Trust and do all or any of the duties relating to the General Secretary under this Claus. The General Secretary shall attend to the correspondence and today affairs of the Trust. The General Secretary shall carry out all the resolution of the Trust and for that purpose he shall have power to incur necessary expenditure form and cut of the funds of the Trust, subject to a maximum of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) only and anything in excess of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) only is to be incurred with the sanction of the Board. He shall have the custody of the correspondence and other books relating to the affairs of the Trust.

**TREASURER:**

The Treasurer shall conduct and receive all sorts of subscriptions, donations and deposit or money and grant receipts of money thereof. He will maintain and keep cash book and such other books of accounts as are necessary.

**11. FOUNDER MEMBERS:**

All the Trustees as well as the Settler of this Trust Deed dated constituted on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 2014 shall be the member for life.

**12. NO PERSON BEING:-**

- i) An undercharged insolvent; or
- ii) Convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude. Or
- iii) Of unsound mind or
- iv) A minor;
- v) Shall be eligible to be a Trustee.

13. The Board of Trustees may, by a unanimous vote of all the Trustees for the time being except the Trustee proposed to be removed, remove any Trustee, permanent or otherwise, from office after finding the Trustee proposed to be removed guilty of serious misconduct in relation to or covering the trust estate or trust estate or trust affairs and after arriving at definite conclusion that for the reasons to be recorded in within the continuance of

the Trustee proposed to be removed as Trustee or these presents was desirable keeping to the object of the trust in view other related or connected matters provided however that on conclusion of such shall be arrived at without giving to the Trustee proposed to be removed a full and fair opportunity of explaining his conduct and/or the charges leveled against his for his removal and the decision of the Board of Trustees in this behalf shall final and binding and shall not be called nay question anywhere.

14. **APPOINTMENT OF THEIR EMPLOYEES:**

They shall have also power employ necessary staff for management, administration and running of the Trust in general and of institution in particular on such reasonable salaries and remunerations and on such terms as may be appear proper, to the Trustees for managing the affairs of the Trust and the Institutions and for the purpose of achieving of the objects of the Trust. They may be allotted or entrusted with such duties and responsibilities.

15. To open bank accounts of the trust in the name of the Trust or Trustee in any Scheduled or Co-Operative Bank or Nationalized Banks as may be decided upon by them from time to time and to close such accounts and to open new ones in any such Bank or Banks and providing the operation by President, Secretary and Treasurer jointly or as shall be decided mutually in meeting of the **TRUSTEE BOARD.**

16. **THAT** the **TRUSTEES** may engage themselves and carry on any business for and on behalf of the **TRUST** established by this Deed and may invest any part of funds or assets of the **TRUST** fund in such business or Businesses for the benefit of the beneficiaries and in such case individually that **TRUSTEE** shall remain responsible for his wrong and loss and for this the **TRUST MANAGING TRUSTEE** and the **SETTLER** shall remain indemnified:

17. **THAT** the **TRUSTEES** shall maintain the true and fair account of the **TRUST FUNDS**, receipts and disposed of or spent and all matters in cours of management of this **TRUST**, in respect thereof or in relation to the carrying out of the object and effects to the **TRUST PROPERTY**. The accounting year of the **TRUST** shall be accounted for i.e. from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 31<sup>st</sup> March, of each English calendar year:

18. **THAT** the number of **TRUSTEES** shall be not less than 2(Two) and not more than 15 (fifteen). If there shall be any vacancies of the office of the **TRUSTEES** the same shall be filled up by the



continuing remaining **TRUSTEE** or **TRUSTEES** by the process nomination in consultation with and acceptance of the **SETTLER**.

19. **THAT** the **TRUSTEES** shall have the full power to compromise or to compound all actions against such suits and settle all accounts relating to the **TRUST PROPERTY** and to do all suits and settle all accounts relating as fully and effectually as if they were absolutely entitled to the **TRUST PROPERTY** without being liable or answerable for any loss thereby.
20. **THAT** the receipt of the **TRUST** for any money, stocks, funds, shares, securities or investments paid delivered or transferred to them in execution of the **TRUST** or power hereof shall effectually be released and discharged the persons paying delivering or transferring the same.
21. **THAT** the **TRUSTEES** jointly shall be responsible for such money, stocks, shares, funds and securities as they actually receive notwithstanding their respectively signing a receipt jointly with other for the sake of conformity and shall be answerable and accountable for the account, receipts neglects and any banker, broker or other person or persons with whom or whose hands any **TRUST** moneys or securities may come or be deposited or given or for insufficiency or deficiency of any stocks, shares, funds or other securities nor for any other loss unless the same shall happen through their default or negligence respectively:
22. **THAT** the **TRUSTEES** shall reimburse and pay and discharge out of the **TRUST FUND** all expenses incurred in course of the execution and administration of the **TRUSTEES** and in uses or for carrying out their duties these presents but they shall not be entitled to any honorarium or salary for the **TRUST**:
23. **THAT** in case of difference of opinion among the **TRUSTEES** decision of the majority **TRUSTEE** as the case may be shall prevail and by every three months meeting of the **BOARD OF TRUSTEE** shall be held and evolution of the works of each member of the **BOARD OF TRUSTEE** shall be made in the annual meeting of the **BOARD** and in that meeting ineffective member of the **BOARD** shall be expelled in proper system:
24. **THAT** any **TRUSTEE** may delegate in writing all or any of his or her powers under these presents to his or her **CO-TRUSTEE** as nominee who will be entitled to exercise such power or powers. In the same manner as the **TRUSTEE** himself could do personally notwithstanding anything herein contained the **TRUSTEE** shall be entitled to use the name of the **TRUST** in connection with any matter relating to the said **TRUST** and for the purposes the said **MANAGING TRUSTEE** for the **TRUST** shall appoint, dismiss and

reappoint any staff, manager, lawyer, adviser, advocate, auditor and substitutes and pay their expenses and fees as shall be deemed reasonable from time to time and for the purposes of the said matters and actions in Courts or otherwise the **TRUSTEES** or any of them or the **MANAGING TRUSTEE** shall be entitled to sign and verify all complaints, petitions, pleadings, written statements memorandums, Vakalatnamas powers the **TRUSTEES** or any of them shall be entitled to appear for and on behalf of the **TRUST** and give evidence orally or adduce any evidence and take necessary proceedings on the said matters and actions:

25. **THAT** a resolution in written circulated amongst all the **TRUSTEES** duly signed by them shall be valid and effective as if it has been passed at a meeting of the **TRUSTEES** duly called and convened:
26. **THAT** any of the **TRUSTEES** may retire from trusteeship if he or she so desires, but with acceptable reasons:
27. **THAT** the power to appoint/nominate new or additional **TRUSTEES** so as not to exceed the maximum number of **TRUSTEES** existing herein and to fill vacancy in the office of the **TRUSTEE** shall vest in the continuing **TRUSTEE** or **TRUSTEES**.
28. **THAT** on a new **TRUSTEE** being appointed/nominated on his signing the Minute Book to holding the effect of his possession of the **TRUST PROPERTIES** shall vest in him along with the other **TRUSTEES** for the time being and he will be entitled to carry out the duties and function of a **TRUSTEE**:
29. **THAT** for amendment or change of any clause of this **TRUST DEED** the **MANAGING TRUSTEE** shall prepare it and get it accepted by the **BOARD OF TRUSTEE**: **THAT** in case members of **BOARD OF TRUSTEE** decide finally in the meeting of the **BOARD OF TRUSTEE** that they shall not continue the **TRUST** any more, they shall after clearing all the accounted liabilities fully of the **TRUST** from the proceeds of the assets of the **TRUST**, wind up THE **TRUST** legally, and shall handover all the residue assets of the **TRUST** to a similar **CHARITABLE TRUST** or The Government who will carry on all the works of this **TRUST**.
30. **THAT** in all meetings of the **TRUSTEES** 3/4<sup>th</sup> of the existing **TRUSTEES** will form a quorum provided however, that if the number of **TRUSTEES** fall below 3/4<sup>th</sup> then for the purpose of appointing a **TRUSTEE** 1/2 of the existing **TRUSTEE** will be a quorum.
31. **INVESTMENT OF TRUST FUNDS:**
  1. The Board of Trustees shall have the power to invest the funds, assets and properties of the Trust at their discretion in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.



2. The Board shall also determine from time to time, the amount it shall spend on the various activities of the Trust.

**32. AMENDMENTS:**

1. While this Trust shall be irrevocable, the Board of Trustees may amend any of the clauses except those relating to objects of the Trust, the First Managing Trustee and First Trustees, at a duly convened meeting of the Board with at least 2 weeks' notice, and by a resolution passed by at least three-fourths majority of the Board of Trustees present and voting. The amendments to the Trust deed, can only be passed by a resolution of the Board of Trustees in an actual meeting and not by circulation.
2. If any alteration or amendment is necessary, the same shall be affected through supplementary deed/deeds with the previous approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax and these shall be read together with the main Trust deed.

**33. INDEMNITY:**

The Board of Trustees shall be indemnified for any act done by them in good faith in the course of the administration of the Trust.

**34. APPLICABILITY OF TRUST ACT:**

The provisions of the Indian Trust Act 1882 shall apply to all matters not specifically mentioned in these presents.

**35. APPLICATION OF INCOME TAX ACT:**

All clauses herein are intended to secure exemption from Income Tax on the income of contributions and donations to the Trust and any clause or portion of this Deed of Trust which is inconsistent with or repugnant to the sections of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended, substituted or modified from time to time, shall be deemed to be deleted or modified with effect from the date on which the sections to which the clause or part of a clause is repugnant or inconsistent comes into force.

**36. DISSOLUTION:**

In the event of dissolution of the Trust, the entire Trust funds shall be realized and first be used for payment of liabilities of the Trust. The assets left if any, shall be disbursed to other Trusts or Associations having similar objectives after obtaining previous approval of Commissioner of Income-tax and in no event it shall be distributed in any manner, to any of the Board of Trustees or their relatives or related concerns.

**DECLARATION:**

This Trust and Scheme set forth under Indenture shall come into force immediately after the execution and registration thereof. The Settlor and Trustees above named also hereby declare that they have consented to be the Trustee under this Trust and that in witnesses whereof the Settlor, Trustees above named as party hereto have affixed their signature hereunder.



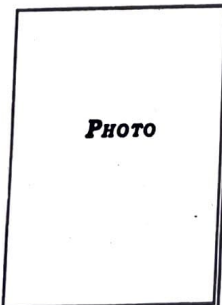


